

POOL RULES

1. Un-potty trained babies/infants must wear snug fitting swim diapers with elastic around legs.
2. No food or drinks (of any kind) except water are allowed on pool deck and/or spa area.
3. No floating or other toys, balls, etc. permitted in the pools or spa areas. Personal flotation devices should be Coast Guard approved.
4. No pets are allowed in the pool and/or spa areas at any time with the exception of a certified Seeing Eye Dog or dogs for the hearing impaired.
5. Bicycles, roller skates, in-line skates, skateboards, scooters, etc. are not allowed in the pool and/or spa areas at anytime.
6. Only persons dressed in regulation swim wear will be allowed in the pool and/or spa. No t-shirts and/or cutoffs.
7. Climbing over the gates, fences and walls to the pool and spas is prohibited and is considered trespassing and will be dealt with in a lawful manner.
8. People with skin disorders, colds, and communicable diseases are requested to refrain from using the pool and/or spas for the obvious health risks.
9. Immoral, lewd, indecent conduct or foul language in the pool and/or spa area will not be tolerated and you may be asked to leave the facility.
10. No electrical appliances are permitted in the pool and/or spa areas. Small battery operated radios, TV's, tape players, CD players, iPods, etc. may be played with ear/headphones worn to control sound.
11. No smoking in the pool and/or spa areas
12. Dispose of trash properly in a trash can.
13. To swim in the "deep end" one may be asked to pass a swim test as requested by the attendant. This test will consist of swimming across the shallow end and back, non-stop.
14. The diving board may be closed at the discretion of the attendant.
15. Violation of any of these rules and procedures may result in a fine and/or denial of pool and/or spa privileges. Your pass may be confiscated or revoked.
16. Pool attendants and Supervisors are authorized by the Tahoe Keys Property Owners Association to administer these rules and procedures. They need your support in order to make these facilities safe and keep them in proper working order. Your safety comes first and a spirit of cooperation, common sense and decency is needed for these facilities.

****NOTICE****

In order to use the diving board you must be able to swim in the deep end of the pool unattended and without floatation devices.

Children who need assistance from parents on the diving board or swimming in the pool are prohibited from using the diving board.
